# Night is Coming!

Jesus healed a blind man. Before working the miracle, the Lord declared, "We must work the works of Him who sent me while it is day; night is coming, when no one can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world" (Jn. 9:4-5).

Jesus knew his purpose in coming to earth. He was sent to "preach the good news of the kingdom of God" (Lk. 4:43); He came to heal (Lk. 4:18). He descended to seek and save the lost (Lk. 19:10). He brought the abundant life. (Jn. 10:10).


