## His Last Words

While nailed to the cross, Jesus speaks on seven occasions, as recorded in the Gospels. His last words profoundly demonstrate His love, compassion, humanity, and identity as God incarnate.

After being beaten and flogged to the brink of death, His ability to speak at all is testament to His determination to finish His Father's plan. Medical experts today confirm that talking while being crucified was both extremely difficult and excruciatingly painful.

Our Savior's first words on the cross are to ask His Heavenly Father to forgive those who wrongfully condemned and crucified Him. What a beautiful example of compassion! *Luke 23:34*

Jesus later rewards the penitent thief with *salvation*, a marvelous gift of grace that He alone – as God – can grant. *Luke 23:43*

He asks His disciple John to care for His aging mother. Christ's concern for her wellbeing was paramount during His final hour. *John 19:26-27*

Then comes that single, most significant moment in history when Christ bears *all* of mankind's sins, the *only* time when His Father – Who cannot be in the presence of sin – departs from Him. We know Jesus felt truly abandoned when He asks, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" *Matthew 27:46, Mark 15:34*

Jesus shows His human frailty when He says, "I thirst." It also fulfills prophecy that David wrote in Psalm 69:21. *John 19:28*

Christ announces His victory over sin and fulfillment of God's perfect plan of salvation by declaring, "It is finished." Those three powerful words underscore His life and ministry. *John 19:30*

As death finally comes, Jesus the Son entrusts His Spirit into His Father's arms, proving His unity with Almighty God. *Luke 23:46*

While He lived among us, Jesus set the perfect, holy example of how we are to serve God. Even in His death, as He writhed in agony and His precious blood drained away, He continued to demonstrate His love, selflessness, humility, and forgiveness.

He died for you. Are you living for Him?
