# The Way Is Hard

By faith Moses, when he was grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to be mistreated with the people of God than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. He considered the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward (Hebrews 11:24-26).

Satan slithered up to Jesus and offered to give Him the kingdoms of the world and all their glory in Matthew 4:9. Jesus rebuked him and instead chose to be faithful unto God. Several hundred years earlier, Moses was basically offered the same bargain, and he too chose the harder path, because at the end of the harder path was a greater reward than anything this world can offer.

Satan is like a payday loan office. He offers us immediate gratification followed by a lifetime of high interest payments. People of faith understand that the easy way is most often the wrong way; the quick fix almost always produces a bigger problem.

To choose Christ is to choose a life that will be filled with obstacles in the here and now. Jesus told us as much in Matthew 7:13-14, where He said, "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few."

Moses chose Christ and a life of hardship and abuse over the life offered to him by Pharaoh, a life of ease and pleasure. This choice caused him a lot of problems all the long days of his life, but because of this choice, we know that he has an eternal reward that will never fade or diminish in value. To choose Jesus is to choose a difficult life in the here and now, but it is also a choice that will bring a joy that is better than pleasure, riches more valuable than money, peace more precious than power, fulfillment that outweighs gratification, and a love that is far better than lust.

Whether it means resting in the green pastures or walking through the valley of the shadow of death, it is always better to choose Jesus.
