SING UNTO THE LORD

In Ephesians 5:19, Paul writes: *"Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord" (Eph. 5:19)*. It is clear from this verse and others that God wants His people to sing. The Psalmist encourages us to sing unto the Lord. In Psalm 96:1-2, David writes: *"O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day" (Psa. 96:1-2)*. Our singing is to come in the form of psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. Today we have brethren fighting over new songs and old songs. Paul said psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. There is something here for all of us. Just sing!

The only music that God is pleased with is music from the heart. We are to sing and make melody in our heart. The heart is our means of genuinely praising God. Personally, I am glad it's the heart and not the vocal cords. Singing is something that we can all do.

Our primary motive is to praise God. It's not to exalt ourselves or see how well we can blend our voices, to show off. What is the worst thing that could be said about our singing? Not that the song leader was off-key, but that we did not sing as to genuinely praise God.

Sing unto the Lord.
