SING UNTO THE LORD

In Ephesians 5:19, Paul writes: "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord" (Eph. 5:19). It is clear from this verse and others that God wants His people to sing. The Psalmist encourages us to sing unto the Lord. In Psalm 96:1-2, David writes: "10 sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. ²Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day" (Psa. 96:1-2).
